This course was one of the most thorough and well presented I have ever attended. The sheer quantity and quality of material taught was remarkable for a course lasting only 3 days. Despite the immense amount of material to cover, the course was taught in a very relaxed and enjoyable way. What I have learned has already benefited my practice on a number of occasions. It is unusual to retain quite so much information after a course, but Clive's teaching makes it interesting and enjoyable, and the beautifully presented 200 page book he provides make it very easy to refresh your memory networks...
